ADVENT CONCERT NEXT SUN, DEC 11 AT 5:00PM



The choir will be singing two masterworks for voices and chamber orchestra: Midnight Mass for Christmas Eve by Marc-Antoine Charpentier and The First Nowell by Ralph Vaughan Williams. Charpentier, active during the reign of Louis XIV and an associate of Moliere, found success as a composer of both sacred and secular music. The Midnight Mass was likely composed for the principal Jesuit church in Paris, St. Louis. Charming and tuneful, it incorporates a number of French Christmas carols, or noels. Similarly, Vaughan Williams weaves familiar melodies throughout The First Nowell, crafting a loose narrative from beloved English carols.

YOU HAVE UNTIL DECEMBER 31ST TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS SPECIAL TAX BENEFIT!

On December 31, 2011, the special tax-code provision that allows donors to make a tax-free gift from their IRA account to Church of the Magdalen will expire. And, with Washington focused on saving money wherever it can find it, it is very unlikely that this tax benefit will be extended.

Here are the rules:

- You must be 70 ½ years of age or older;
 - You may give up to \$100,000 (married couples can give \$200,000)
- Your contribution can help Church of the Magdalen fulfill its mission to provide ministry to our parishioners, to maintain its campus, or to prepare for its growth.
