Please make note of the following items related to enrollment in a Catholic school for the 2012 / 2013 school year:

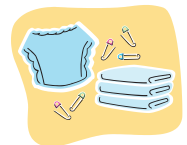
- There is a **mandatory meeting** for all Catholic school parents that plan to enroll a child in a Catholic school next year for grades Kindergarten through 12th. The mandatory meetings will be held in the Church the weekend of January 28th and 29th after each of the Masses. If you cannot attend one of these four meetings, you must contact the parish office to schedule an appointment with Father York.
- As a stewardship-based parish, all parishioners, regardless of whether they have school children, are expected to sacrificially and proportionately practice stewardship, consisting of regular mass attendance, contributing of their time and talent, and contributing of their tithe in order to allow the parish to continue to provide a Catholic education to those families practicing stewardship. If any family is unable to meet its good-faith commitment, please contact the parish office to schedule an appointment with Father York.

"STEWARDSHIP: SHARING THESE GIFTS IN LOVE OF GOD AND NEIGHBOR"

We often find it difficult to listen for the voice of God. In fact, when we pray, do we reverse the words of Samuel and say "Listen Lord, for your servant is speaking?" The readings help us understand why we must listen to God's voice. Samuel heard God and delivered His messages to the Israelites. John the Baptist pointed out the Lord to Andrew who shared his discovery with his brother Simon. May we listen for God's voice and share His message at once with our neighbors.
